### Three Pirates Earn PBC All-Academic Men's Tennis Honors

**SAVANNAH, Ga.** - Three members of the Armstrong State University men's tennis team have earned spots on the 2015 Peach Belt Conference's Men's Tennis All-Academic Team, released last week.

Juniors **Otakar Lucak** and **Pablo Gor**, as well as sophomore **Luca Cerin**, each earned spots on the team, which is part of a season-long program recognizing the outstanding accomplishments of PBC student-athletes in the classroom as well as on the field. To be eligible for the All-Academic team, a student-athlete must 1) participate in at least half of his/her team's events and be either a starter or significant contributor; 2) achieved a 3.30 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) and 3) completed at least one full academic year at his or her current institution and has reached sophomore athletic eligibility.

Lucak carries a 3.727 GPA in international economics. Gor, meanwhile, carries a 3.329 GPA in business economics and Cerin carries a 3.372 GPA, also in business economics. All three earn their first PBC All-Academic Team honors.
