Motion:

I move that the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Evaluations formed in 2004-05 academic year be dissolved and replaced with a new Faculty Senate Committee Standing Committee on Student Evaluations to review the student evaluations issues raised by the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Evaluations.

Rationale:

The issues raised by the faculty on the Ad Hoc Committee were broader and more complex in context than the original charge given the the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Evaluations last year. Therefore I feel it would aid the faculty, as a whole, to discuss the list of issues outlined in the last meeting of the Committee that has been posted to all Faculty Senate members.

Response:

The SEC declined to schedule this motion request. Upon closer review, the general issue of evaluations is one of the responsibilities of the Faculty Welfare committee ("c. monitor existing evaluation procedures, instruments,

validity, collections and distributions of data".)

We will refer ongoing student evaluations to them.
