Collection previously known as "Henderson Library Special Collections oral history collection" and "Special Collections oral history collection."

This collection was subject to multiple iterations of transcription. As a result, discrepancies in the historic record may exist, primarily due to the use of modified language in reference to outdated phrasing and terms. Attempts have been made to correct and minimize such discrepancies to reflect the accurate historical record.

ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Administrative History: The Zach S. Henderson Library's Special Collections Department was founded in the 1970s. Housed within the department are rare books, manuscript collections, and artifacts relating to the history of the Statesboro region and Georgia Southern University. Special Collections at Georgia Southern University Libraries was established to collect, organize, describe, preserve, and make available materials of permanent institutional and historical value to the University and the local community. Collections span both the Armstrong and Statesboro campuses and include personal papers, organizational records, photographs, campus publications, ephemera, rare books,

and digitally-born materials. Special Collections also presents exhibits and forums for lectures, presentations and academic discussions.

The Department of History at Georgia Southern University aims to educate students about the past by blending traditional and contemporary approaches to the study and teaching of history, and by emphasizing global perspectives while recognizing the value of local and regional history. The faculty of the Department of History values diversity of historical approaches and is dedicated to excellence in teaching and scholarship as means to continue individual, professional growth.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of the transcripts, original cassette tape recordings of public speeches, lectures, and oral history interviews spanning from 1962-2007. Interviews were conducted and recorded by Georgia Southern University's Department of History and Zach S. Henderson Library Special Collections. Those interviewed are mostly locals to Bulloch County and neighboring counties. Interviewees discuss their personal and family lives, historical events they were a part of, and circumstances surrounding their successes. The public speeches and lectures originated from an assortment of sources.
