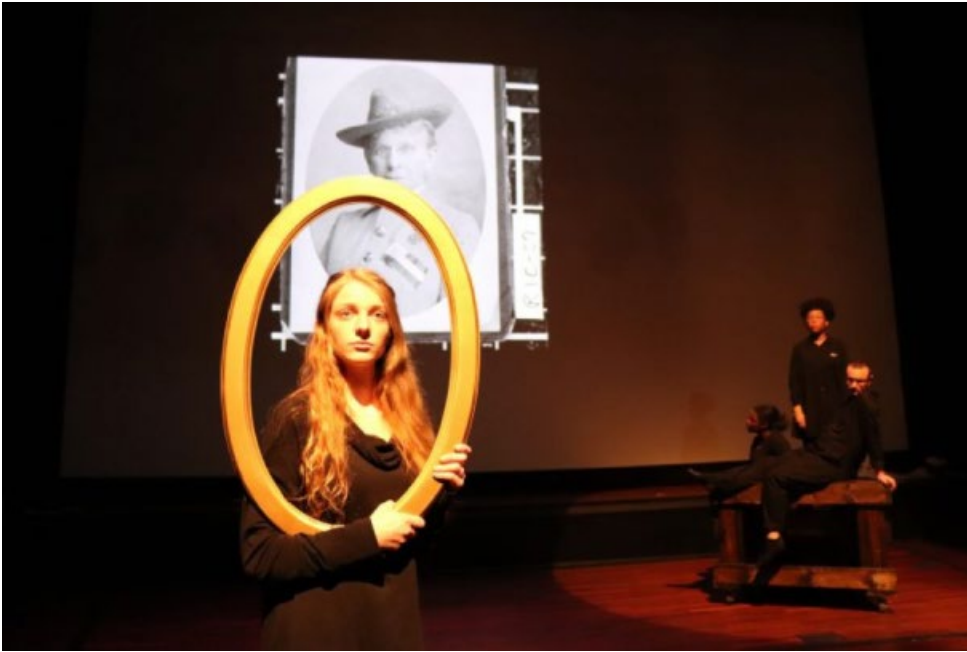
Armstrong Campus' Southern Café, aquaponics farm-to-table partnership offers sustainable, healthy food options

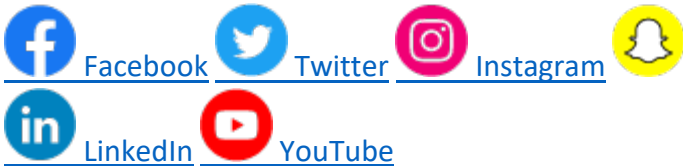
