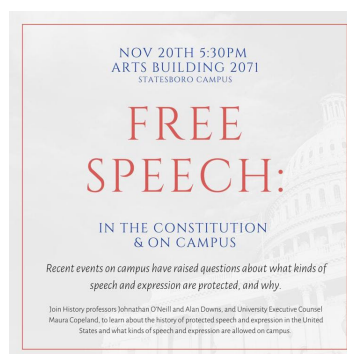
M.O.V.E meets with Statesboro law enforcement to facilitate conversation
