### Rumenov, Regan Also Advance At ITA Small College National Championships

**MOBILE, Ala.** - Armstrong Atlantic State University seniors **Georgi Rumenov** and **Daniel Regan** advanced to the DII doubles bracket final after a pair of wins on Thursday on the first day of the ITA Small College National Championships at the Copeland-Cox Tennis Center in Mobile, Ala.

Rumenov also picked up a first-round DII Singles bracket victory, knocking off Vishwesh Sinha of Bluefield State, 6-2, 6-3. The top seed in the singles bracket, Rumenov will now face Concordia (NY) fourth seed Daniele Piludu at 10:30 a.m. on Friday.

Regan and Rumenov, the top seed in the doubles bracket, then won a pair of matches to advance to the DII doubles final. The duo knocked off Yevhen Zakharov and Martin Chonjnacki of BYU-Hawaii 7-6 (4), 6-2, in the first round, then downed Piludu and Antony Boldarev of Concordia (NY), the fourth seeded duo, 6-0, 3-6, (10-8), to earn the berth in the final.

The duo will face third-seeded Marco Mokrzycki and Fabian Groetsch of Barry at 5:00 p.m. on Friday.

The winners of the DII singles and doubles brackets advance to the ITA "Super Bowl" of Small College Tennis bracket, pitting the winners of the DII, DIII, NAIA and NJCAA Brackets for a chance to earn a wild card entry in the ITA National Indoor Championships.
