Bridget Conn's work will be featured in the group show "Depth of Field," an exhibition of contemporary photography that encompasses a multitude of methods and processes, at the [Spartanburg Art Museum](#) in Spartanburg, South Carolina. The exhibition runs Sept. 17 until Dec. 30, with an opening reception at 6:30 p.m. on Sept.17.

One of Bridget Conn's works was selected for "Let There Be," an exhibition at [Manifest Gallery](#) in Cincinnati, Ohio. This exhibit showcases "works that reveal the 'objectness' of photography either through the display of the works themselves, the mechanisms crafted to create lens-based experiences, dialogs between photographic works and their physical subjects, or narrative works explaining the complicated entanglement of light and form." It runs from Sept. 25 – Oct. 23.
