Four of our own GSU authors will be among the 25 Georgia writers presenting at The Georgia Literary Festival, October 23, 10 am to 5 pm, at the Nessmith-Lane Continuing Education Building.

- Lori Amy, Associate Professor of Writing and Linguistics, will discuss *The Wars We Inherit*.
- Rebecca Davis, Associate Professor of Political Science, will present *Judge Faye Sanders Martin: Head Full of Sense, Heart Full of Gold*.
- Sonya Huber, Assistant Professor of Writing and Linguistics, will share *Opa Nobody*.
- Eric Nelson, Professor of Writing and Linguistics, will read from *The Twins*.

They join a collection of distinguished authors for adults and children:

- Max Cleland, Vietnam veteran and former U.S. Senator
- Ferrol Sams, legendary southern storyteller
- Natasha Trethewey, Pulitzer Prize-winning poet
