# Printing on campus

December 20, 2010

As of the fall semester of 2010, printing on campus (including Henderson Library) is managed with a credit system. Each individual is allowed to print 700 pages per semester. If you need more, there is an appeal process. Please see the online appeal form [here](#).

The networked printer system keeps track of these 700 pages in monetary terms, that is, 700 pages = \$70 (10 cents per page). This is not “real money” on your account that could be refunded if unused. Instead, it’s simply a page limit, and it is reset for each new semester.
