Three Pirates Alive At ITA Southeast Regional

SAVANNAH, Ga. - Three members of the Armstrong Atlantic State University men's tennis team are still alive after Sunday's third day of action at the ITA Southeast Regional, hosted at the Palmetto Tennis Center in Sumter, S.C.

Freshman Jean-Michael Blouin advanced to the semifinals with a pair of wins on Sunday. He upset top-seeded Paul-Henri Arrigoni of Lander, 6-1, 6-4, in the Round of 16, then defeated Martin Shishkov of Columbus State, 6-3, 3-0, retired. Blouin will face Queens (NC) No. 3 seed Christiaan Lee-Daigle in the semifinals on Monday morning.

Fellow newcomer **Sven Lalic** advanced to the quarterfinals with a 6-2, 6-4 win over Flavio Rathsam of Wingate, but fell to Lee-Daigle in the quarters, 2-6, 6-2, 6-3.

Junior No. 9-16 seed **Daniel Regan** finished off his rain-halted match from Saturday, winning 6-4, 4-6, 6-2 over Guilherme Destefani of USC Aiken, but fell to No. 5-8 seed Jerome Leborgne of Georgia College, 6-0, 6-4, in the Round of 16.

Fellow No. 9-16 seed **Pedro Scocuglia** collected a 6-0, 6-2 win over No. 4-seeded Bernardo Fernandes of Augusta State to advance to the quarterfinals, but succumbed to Leborgne, 7-6 (4), 6-4, in the quarters.

No. 2-seed **Matus Mydla** suffered a 6-4, 6-4 loss to No. 9-16 seed Henrique Boturao of Augusta State in the Round of 16.

In doubles action, the No. 4-seeded duo of Mydla and Scocuglia defeated Jenner Stevenson and Max Couloub of Augusta State, 8-5, in the quarterfinals, then led Abdoulaye Camara and Daniel Gonzalez of Anderson, 7-4, when lightning halted play on Sunday.

Mydla and Scocuglia will finish their semifinal doubles match on Monday morning and Blouin will face Daigle at the same time, with the bracket finals following on Monday afternoon. The winner of each of the singles and doubles draw advances to the ITA Small College National Championships in Mobile, Ala., on Oct. 13-16.
