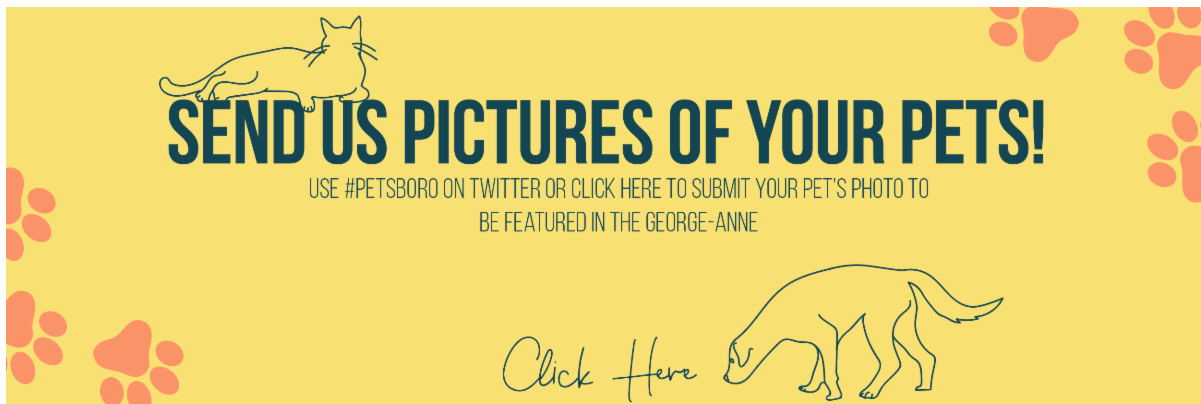

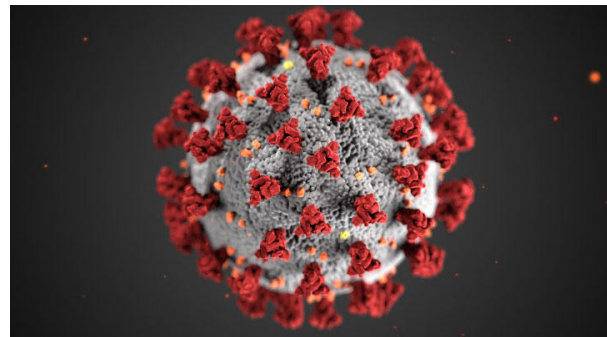

Georgia Southern now releasing COVID-19 numbers to public

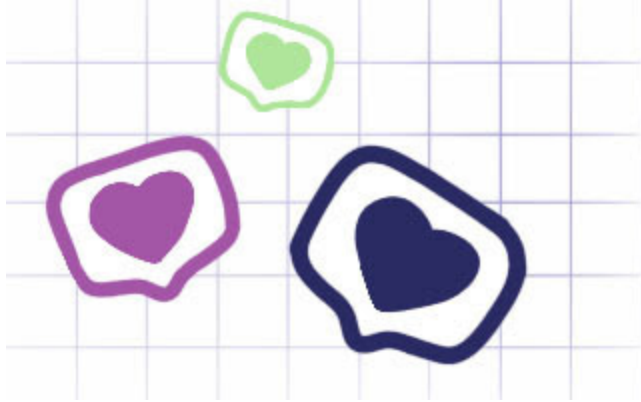
After pleas from campus community members, Georgia Southern officials began releasing self reported and university confirmed COVID-19 numbers to the public on Monday.
