Three Pirates Earn ITA All-America Men's Tennis Honors

SAVANNAH, Ga. - Three members of the Armstrong Atlantic State University men's tennis team have earned All-American honors for the 2010-11 season, announced by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) on Friday afternoon.

Senior **Mikk Irdoja** earned Division II All-American honors in both singles and doubles, while junior Eudaldo Bonet earned honors in singles and senior Rafael Array earned honors in doubles.

A native of Talinn, Estonia, Irdoja earns both singles and doubles All-American honors for a second straight season. Irdoja went 30-7 overall in singles in 2010-11, finishing the season ranked No. 6 in the country, while putting together an outstanding 43-4 doubles record and capping the year ranked No. 1 in the nation in doubles.

Bonet, meanwhile, earns his third straight All-American honor in singles for finishing the 2010-11 season as the top-ranked singles player in NCAA Division II. The Barcelona, Spain, native went 41-3 overall in singles and by virtue of his season-ending top ranking, also earns a spot on the ITA Collegiate All-Stars squad.

Array wrapped up his four-year Pirate career with his third All-American doubles honor as he fashioned a 39-4 overall record in 2010-11, finishing as part of the top-ranked doubles duo in the nation. The Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Spain, native also finishes his career as the all-time leader in wins in Armstrong men's tennis in singles (133), doubles (133) and combined (266).
