OBITUARY

Lummie J. Boyd, daughter of the late Melton and Laura Wiggins, was born in Portal, Bulloch County, Georgia.

She attended the Bulloch County Public School System.

At an early age, she accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal saviour and joined the Scarboro Grove Baptist Church, under the pastoralship of the late Reverend W.D. Dunn. She attended Sunday School and served on the Usher Board, serving faithfully until she came to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
