Georgia Southern University has appointed Jana Briley director of audit and advisory services, effective Nov. 1, 2009.

Briley, a 20-year employee of Georgia Southern University, most recently served as an auditor in Georgia Southern's office of Audit and Advisory Services. Prior to that, she served as an accountant and coordinator of Annual Fund accounts with the Georgia Southern University Foundation. She began her career as an accounting assistant.
