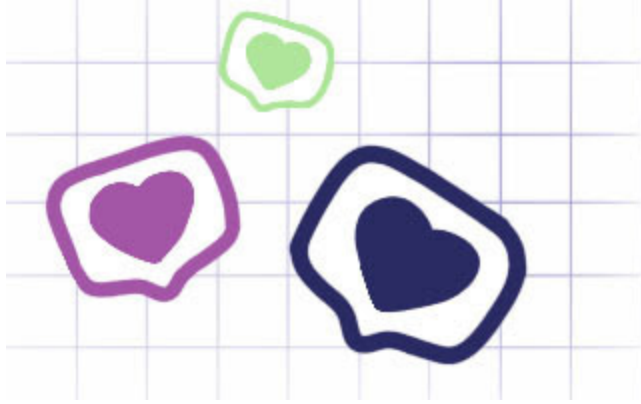
What impacts this could have on the nation and the upcoming election are still unknown, but several students and faculty of Georgia Southern University have made their thoughts on the situation known.

Bulloch County: 2,934 cases, 28 deaths

Chatham County: 8,718 cases, 169 deaths

Liberty County: 1,147 cases, 23 deaths

Statewide: 324,650 cases, 29,154 hospitalizations, 7,229 deaths
