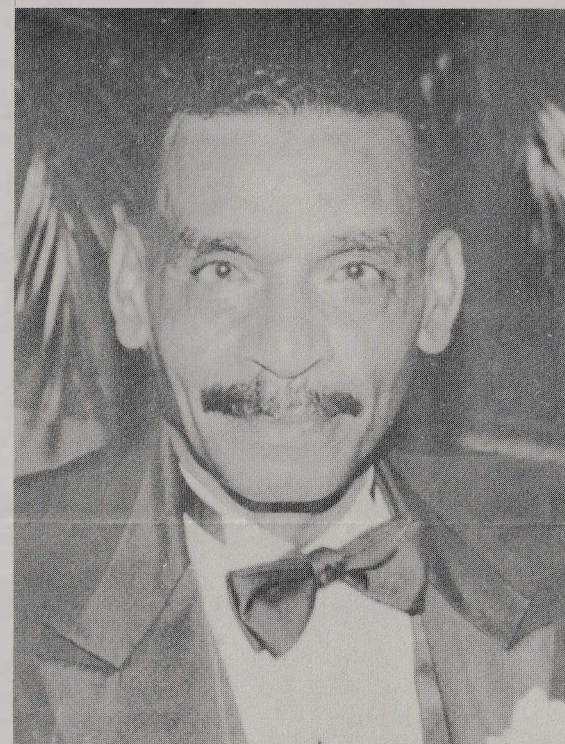

## Obituary
