Top-Ranked Pirates Blank North Georgia, 9-0

**SAVANNAH, Ga.** - The top-ranked and two-time NCAA Division II national champion Armstrong Atlantic State men's tennis team notched a 9-0 Peach Belt Conference victory over visiting North Georgia on Saturday afternoon at Bacon Park.

The Pirates (20-0, 7-0 PBC) stretched their current win streak to 43 with the win, while handing North Georgia (1-16, 1-7 PBC) its 10th straight loss.

AASU dropped just one game each match in sweeping the three doubles matches from the Saints to start things off. Matus Mydla and Daniel Regan defeated Grant Partrick and Brandon Sloan, 8-1, at No. 1 doubles, while Eudaldo Bonet and Paul Fitzgerald beat Daniel Aquilon and Adrien Saulais, 8-1, at No. 2 doubles. **Victor Saez** and Simon Verpoort completed the doubles sweep with an 8-1 win over Parker LaSure and Andy McMaster at No. 3 doubles.

The Pirates then completed the match with straight-set wins in all six singles matches. Bonet defeated Aquilon, 6-2, 6-3, at No. 1 singles, while Mydla blanked Partrick, 6-0, 6-0, at No. 2 singles and Regan bested Sloan, 6-1, 6-1, at No. 3 singles.

38th-ranked Fitzgerald shut out Saulais, 6-0, 6-0, at No. 4 singles and Verpoort also blanked LaSure, 6-0, 6-0, at No. 5 singles. Saez picked up a 6-0, 6-1 win over McMaster at No. 6 singles to round things out for AASU.

The Pirates return to action on Monday, April 5, with a 3:00 p.m. match against No. 30-ranked Lees-McRae in Columbia, S.C.
