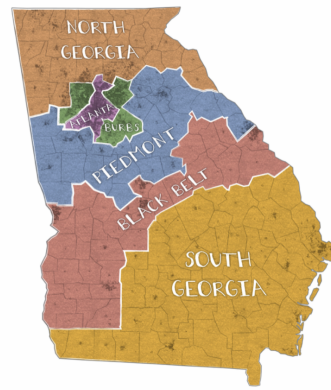
## **New COVID-19 cases up 62% in Georgia since last week, health officials say (WSB-TV)**

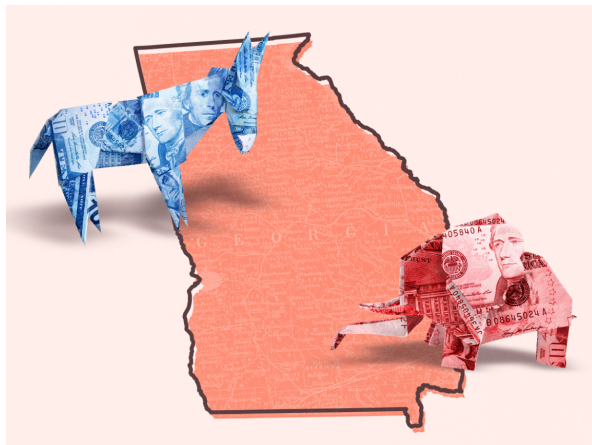
