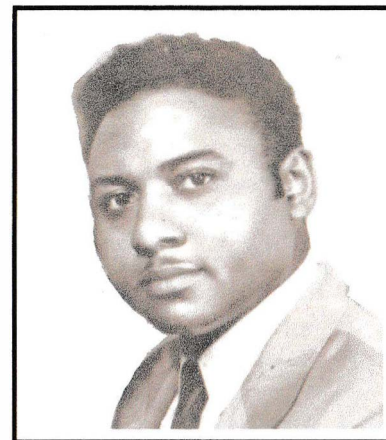

At an early age he became a member of the Scarboro Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Portal, Georgia. In 1947, he joined the United States Army. In 1953, he returned home from the military and decided to reside in Miami, Florida for 43 years. In 1996, Deacon Burke returned to his roots and decided to place his Christian membership with Simmons Branch Missionary Baptist Church in Sylvania, Georgia. In 1999, he was united in Holy Matrimony to Rozzie L. Gordon.

Deacon Burke passed into eternal rest on Wednesday, April 25, 2007 at Screven County Hospital in Sylvania, Georgia.
