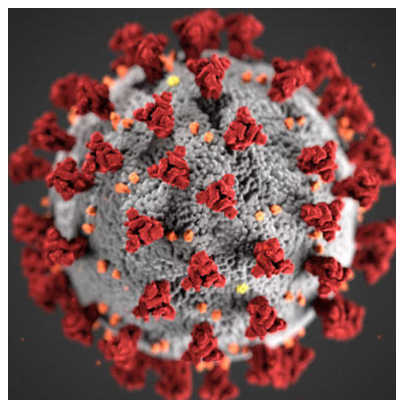

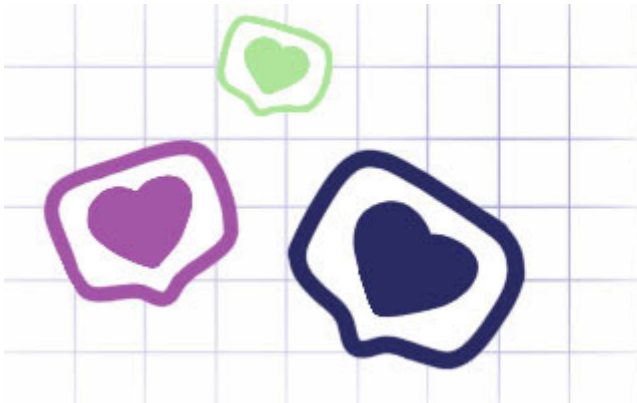
Georgia Southern officials report 108 positive COVID-19 cases in the first week

Bulloch County: 4,241 cases, 41 deaths

Chatham County: 15,020 cases, 264 deaths

Liberty County: 2,091 cases, 33 deaths

Statewide: 689,676 cases, 47,006 hospitalizations, 11,265 deaths
