time towards earning a little extra experience—potentially alongside some additional income. Many students have or are looking into working while attending college, for one reason or another.



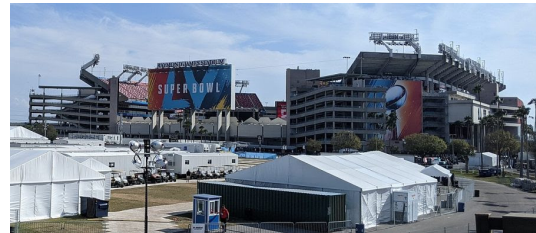
