Double safety, double masking

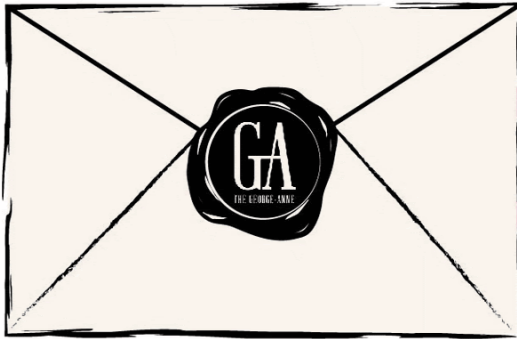
Georgia Southern's medical director discussed the merits and efficacy of "double masking" as new strains of COVID-19 begin to show up.
