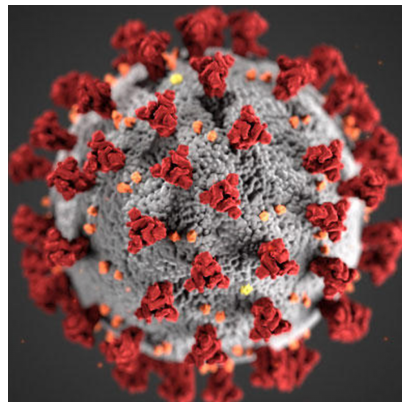
Public Relation Society of America to host annual conference
