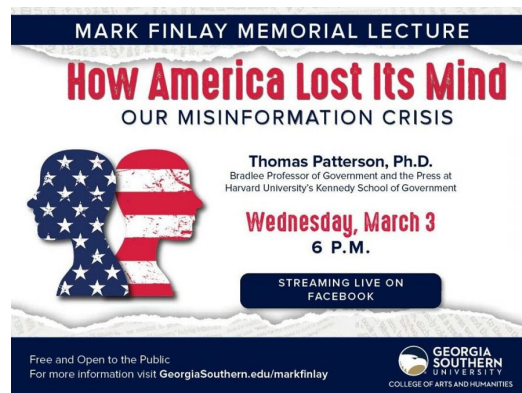
### What is House Bill 531?

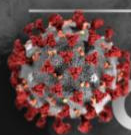
