Campus food pantry providing food for students in need

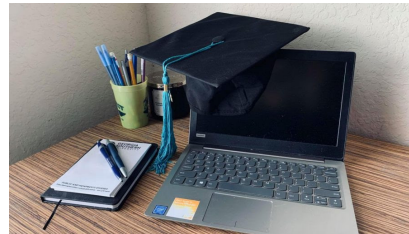
The Eagle's Essentials Pantry is providing free dry and canned goods in the Williams Center to students that may be in need of food.

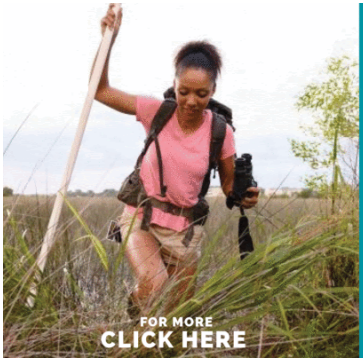
