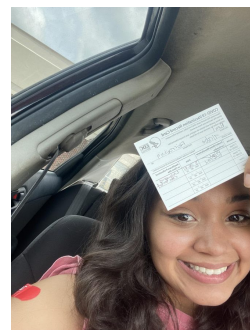
### SGA Elections and who is running

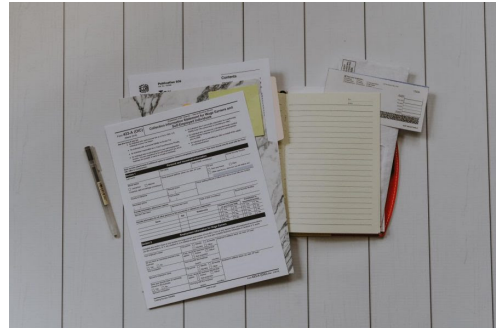
