### Post Vaccination Guidelines

People who have been vaccinated can resume doing things they stopped doing due to the pandemic. However, we still don't know how to vaccine will affect the spread of COVID-19. After you've been fully vaccinated you should still take public precautions such as avoiding large gatherings and poorly ventilated areas.

If you have been fully vaccinated:

- You can have indoor gatherings with other vaccinated people.
- You can have indoor gatherings without a mask with unvaccinated people.
- If exposed to someone who may have COVID-19, you do not have to quarantine or get tested.
