**Deacon Harden Ball** was born to Theo and Beulah Ball on May 29, 1921.

At an early age, he joined the Jerusalem Baptist Church. He was ordained a deacon in February, 1948. He was an active member of the church and served on the Trustee Board, the Building Committee and the Finance Committee.

Deacon Ball was very active in community and civic affairs. He was employed by the Evans County Board of Education for twenty-two years and was a member of St. Joseph Lodge #76.

In 1946, he married Alberta Greene and to this union four children were born; Vivian, Theo (who preceded him in death), Roland, and Euris.
