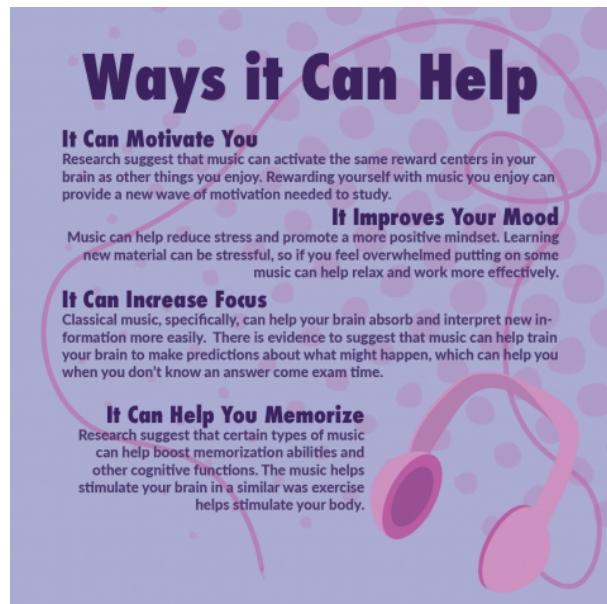
- Track and field finished 32nd out of 32 teams at the NCAA South Regional.
