Rob Costomiris (CAH) noted that one of the oddities is that historically ASU have not paid. In interest of uniformity, the tendency has been to impose a fee on everyone. Why not go the other way?

Trish Holt (COE) claimed that when you pay for something you get something. She noted that the Statesboro campus has defined parking lots. Armstrong does not. She could not find parking in the faculty lot on the Statesboro campus last week.

Robert Whitaker, VP for Business & Finance, said that there is a group working on this.
