Deadlines

The RFP will address three rounds of grants with rolling deadlines:

- Round 3: May 31, 2015
- Round 4: September 7, 2015
- Round 5: December 15, 2015

New Grant Management Software

The official RFP announcement is pending the implementation of new grant management software that will ensure that the grant submission process runs smoothly and reliably. Proposals will be submitted via a self-created account in the online grant management software, which will provide automated communications and support the review and decision process.

Funding Levels and Categories

Two levels of funding will be available (Single Course: \$10,800 or Multiple Sections/Courses/Department-Wide: \$30,000) in three categories of projects (No-Cost-to-Students Learning Materials, OpenStax Textbooks, and [Specific Top 50 Lower Division Courses](#)).

Webinars for Review and Q&A

For each round, there will be at least one open-invitation webinar to review the RFP, the online submission process, and address any questions.
