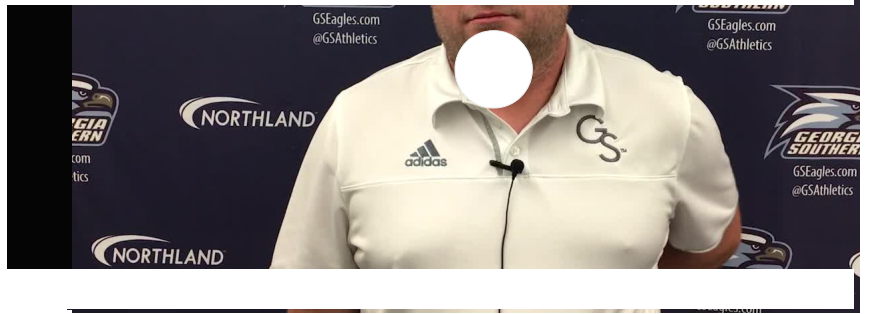
Key Moment
