SHORT TITLE: Academic Standing Appeals Procedures

MOTION(s):

The Academic Standards Committee recommends that the University only re-admit undergraduate students on an appeal in the Fall or Spring semester, not to allow undergraduate students with approved appeals to return in the Summer semester. The SEC moves to accept the recommendation of the revised academic standing appeals procedures.

RATIONALE(s):

Summer classes require an accelerated schedule which is more likely to be problematic for undergraduate students with academic challenges. Although summer enrollment is important and is a good opportunity for many undergraduate students to accelerate their academic progress, undergraduate students who are immediately returning from several unsuccessful semesters are unlikely to perform to their desired ability in a compressed term. The revised procedure was passed by at least a majority to move forward to the Faculty Sena
