Before 1920, any woman who voted broke the law. But we changed the law and the country.

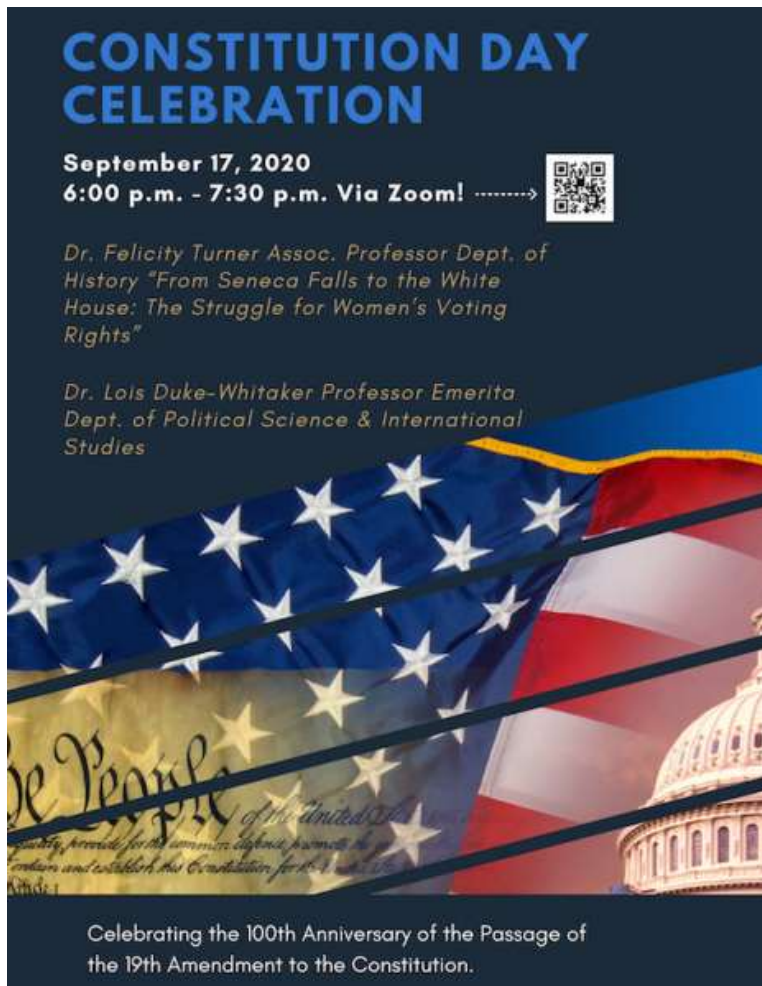
