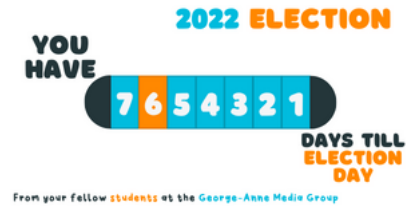
After returning your completed ballot, stay informed on its status.

- To verify that your ballot was accepted visit <https://www.mvp.sos.ga.gov/MVP/mvp.do>
- If your ballot gets rejected, your county elections office will contact you in order to “cure” or correct your ballot envelope.
- If you do not receive your ballot after submitting an application, contact your county registrar.
