**FERNANDINA BEACH, Fla.** – [Lauren Coe](#) shot a 2-under-par 70, and [Ariana Macioce](#) carded a 72 as the Georgia Southern women's golf team moved up three spots

to 11th place in the second round Monday at Amelia Island National Golf Club.

After two rounds of play today, GS (+34) is a stroke behind Sam Houston State (+33) and four behind Samford (+30) for ninth. The Eagles are seven shots behind a three-team logjam tied for sixth.

Macioce (+5) is tied for 18th after shooting 77-72. Coe, [Iben Hvass](#) and [Ansley Bowman](#) are all +11, and [Yeji Shin](#) is +16. [Taylor Thompson](#), who is playing as an individual this week, shot 81-82.

### **The story**

Coe heated up in her second round, posting a team-leading five birdies. She made par or better with two birdies on seven straight holes in the middle of the round and finished with a flurry, playing the final five holes of the day 3-under for a 70.

Macioce scored par or better with three birdies on her first 13 holes in the second round, and a birdie on hole 1 moved her to 3-under. She also parred the last three holes of the day for a 72.

"We got off to a bit of a rocky start in our opening round, but the team bounced back in the second 18 today. Every single one of them learned something about themselves and their golf games today that I believe will continue to help us grow this season. We are looking forward to a new day and clean slate tomorrow to finish strong! Ari is playing some steady golf and is really developing into a fearless player. Lauren did a great job turning her day around and shot our only under-par round today after a tough opening round. Our goal for tomorrow is to stay in the present moment and commit to our shots - and the results will take care of themselves when we do this!"

The Eagles play the third and final round tomorrow in a shotgun start at 8:30 a.m. GS is paired with Sam Houston State and Tulsa.
