Georgia Southern University alumni will return to campus next week for the University's annual Homecoming Celebration.

The weeklong celebration themed "Wild Wild West in the Eagle's Nest" will feature a number of Western-style festivities for University supporters, alumni, and Eagle fans of all ages to enjoy.

Alumni Director Frank Hook said that Homecoming is the perfect time for the University community to unite in celebration of its accomplishments, both new and old.
