- 2) Lunsford's Home Debut:** It will be the first home game for interim head coach [Chad Lunsford](#) and he's asking the fans to "show up cause [they're] gonna show out." Lunsford has been a coach at GS for nine seasons and is as True Blue as they come. Support the staff and the players as they look for a big win over their in-state rival.

Sign-ups are going on now and space is available until the buses fill up, so take advantage of this opportunity to catch FBS football in the Coastal Empire!
