STATESBORO, Ga. - The Georgia Southern Athletics Department recognized 233 scholar-athletes at Saturday's football game against Georgia State. These student-athletes have found a way to balance playbooks and text books, all earning a term grade point average of a 3.0 or higher in the Spring 2017 semester. Among these student-athletes are 77 Dean's List recipients, as well as 44 scholar-athletes who earned a perfect term GPA of 4.0 and were named to the President's List.

Due to competition, the football, women's soccer and men's soccer scholar-athletes were not on the field.
