Georgia Southern University invites Bluffton and Hilton Head Island area professionals to learn how they can earn a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree while attending classes in Savannah and pay in-state tuition. A drop-in, MBA information session will be held Tuesday, April 9 from 3 p.m. until 8 p.m. at the Hilton Garden Inn located at 1575 Fording Island Road.
