- College of Education Alumnus of the Year: Martha Cain, Ph.D., ('50), retired chemistry professor, Georgia Southern

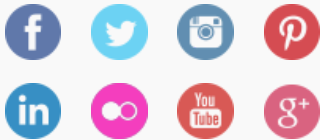
