STATESBORO, Ga – Georgia Southern women's soccer Coach <u>Brian</u> <u>Dunleavy</u> announced Wednesday that <u>Emily Grant</u> will be joining the coaching staff as the new assistant coach.

two years. While with UNLV, Grant was also the head coach of the U-15 and U-17 girls at Heat Football Club in Las Vegas.
