**AUBURN, Ala.-** Saturday evening, No.36 Auburn dealt the Georgia Southern women's tennis team a tough loss, beating them 4-0.

Despite winning the doubles point the past four matches, the Eagles were unable to snag the 1-0 advantage at the Yarbrough Tennis Center. No.2 doubles duo <u>Giulia Riepe</u> and <u>Francisca Norregaard</u> fell 6-0 followed by No.1 pair <u>Lindsay</u> <u>Truscott</u> and <u>Mariana Ranzahuer</u>, who lost 6-2 to the 38th-best doubles team in the nation.

In singles, the Blue and White were unable to get on the board, although freshman <u>Shannon Wagner</u> was up 6-3 at the No.6 spot. The match was called off due to the now 11-1Tigers' clinch. Riepe won three games total against nationally-ranked Andie Dikosavljevic (who sits at No.27 in the country). That match too was left unfinished at 6-1, 5-2.
