“Don’t worry about me I’ll be alright.”

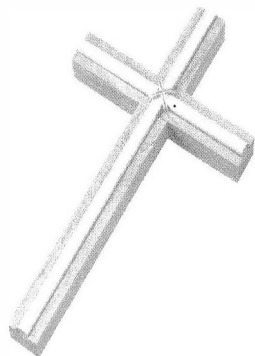
