Here are 10 things about Georgia Southern's upcoming Sun Belt Conference game against South Alabama that will get you ready for the game, which kicks off at 6 p.m. local (7 p.m. Eastern) inside Ladd-Peebles Stadium:

10: **Ten** of Georgia Southern's 12 games will be played on artificial turf, including Saturday's game at South Alabama.

9: [L.A. Ramsby](#) has rushed for a touchdown in **nine** straight games played.

8: **Eight** Eagles made their first collegiate start in the opener against Savannah State.

7: Coach [Tyson Summers](#) became the **seventh** GS coach out of 10 in the modern era

to win his opener.

6: Senior quarterback [Kevin Ellison](#) is one of **six** players all-time at Georgia Southern to both run and pass for 2,000 career yards or more.

5: **Five** different Eagle players scored via rushing touchdown in last week's 54-0 win over Savannah State.

4: Georgia Southern is looking to break a **four**-game losing streak in road openers.

3: [Montay Crockett](#) had a career-high **three** receptions for a career-high 73 yards against Savannah State last week.

2: Georgia Southern is the only FBS team with **two** players on its roster with 2,500 or more career rushing yards.

1: Ladd-Peebles Stadium, the home of the Eagles' **first** bowl game, is the same place GS won its **first** Sun Belt game.
