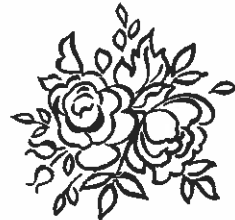

Neomia Facyson was called home to be with our Lord Savior on Thursday, November 23, 1995 at 7:30 a.m.

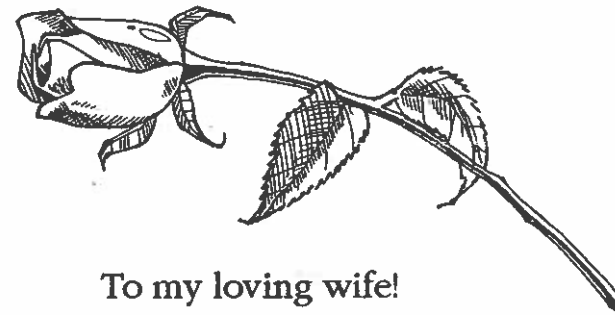
