STATESBORO, Ga. – The Georgia Southern men's tennis team will travel to Tallahassee, Florida to compete in the ITA Regional Championships beginning Wednesday October 19th. Four Eagles will compete in Tallahassee this weekend. [JC Alcalá](#) and [Dani Casablancas](#) earned a spot in the main draw, while [Eddie Landin](#) and [Diego Finkelstein](#) earned spots in the qualifying draw.

The USTA/ITA Southeast Regional Championships will feature athletes from across the southeast, competing in individual and doubles tournaments. The Championships will run from Wednesday October 19th until Monday October 24th. The winner from each of the USTA/ITA Division I Regional Championships will receive an automatic entry into the 2016 USTA/ITA National Indoor Intercollegiate Championships, which will be held on November 3rd through the 6th in Flushing, New York.

"We are looking forward to this tournament. The guys have been working hard after

playing the first tournament and they are excited to go to this one." Said coach [Sander Koning](#). "It's a privilege to play in this tournament, which has a lot good teams participating. We are looking to gain the experience of playing against these good teams, because we will face some of them this upcoming spring."
