## Obituary

Rev. Edgar Cone was born in Bulloch County (Portal), Georgia on March 26, 1903, to Mr. Enoch and Mrs. Sula Donaldson Cone.

He confessed Christ at an early age, when he joined the Scarboro Grove Baptist Church, Portal, Georgia, where he served as a choir member for many years. He was later called into Christian Ministry and served until he became disabled. During his tenure as a minister, he served as pastor of the First Baptist Church of Rocky Ford and the Ogeechee Branch Baptist Church of Newington. He was serving as Moderator of the third District of the Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Association when he became disabled. He was also a member of several other Fraternal and religious organizations.
