- Georgia Southern travels to Troy this weekend to finish off its four-game season series against the Trojans. Both games will be broadcast on ESPN+ and the GS Sports Network.
- GS is third in the Sun Belt East Division, and Troy is tied for fifth.
- The Eagles are coming off a home split against Coastal Carolina, while Troy swept Appalachian State at home and defeated Spring Hill 90-73 Tuesday night for its third straight win.
- GS has 11 scholarship players averaging over 10 minutes a game, and only Zack Bryant averages more than 10 shots a game. Nine different players have led the Eagles in scoring in a game this season.
- Georgia Southern ranks second in the Sun Belt in offensive rebounds per game (12.2).
- Georgia Southern ranks 16th nationally and second in the Sun Belt in steals per game (9.0) and fifth nationally and first in the Sun Belt in total steals (171). The Eagles are 22nd in the country and first in the league in turnovers forced (16.9/gm).
- The Eagles have notched 35 wins away from home in the last four seasons and are 4-5 this year. The most wins away from home in a season in school history is 12 in 1988-89.
- As of Feb. 2, only three teams in the country - Oakland, Toledo and Longwood - have played more games than Georgia Southern.
- Kam Woods currently leads the Sun Belt in scoring among freshman (12.1/gm) and has scored at least 20 points in three of his last six games. Woods has four 20-point games this season.
- Zay Williams has four double-doubles this season and ranks sixth in the league in rebounding (8.4/gm).
- The Trojans rank third in the Sun Belt in scoring defense (67.1/gm).
- Troy is 6-0 at home for the first time in its Division I history. The Trojans are in the midst of a five-game homestand.
