ON THE MORNING OF JUNE 14, 2006 AT HIS RESIDENCE IN PEMBROKE, GEORGIA, THE SWEET SPIRIT OF OUR DEAR BROTHER JOSEPH EDMON WENT TO JOIN THE SAVIOR IN HIS HOME NOT BUILT WITH HANDS, BUT WHOSE MAKER AND BUILDER IS GOD...

JOSEPH THE SON OF THE LATE MR. MAPLE AND CHRISTINE JONES EDMON WAS BORN JULY 30, 1930 IN PEMBROKE, GEORGIA. HE ATTENDED SCHOOL IN PEMBROKE, GEORGIA. AT AN EARLY AGE JOSEPH JOINED SAINT JOHN A.M.E.
